Introduction

Icom Holdings Ltd and its subsidiary companies (*Icom Telecommunications Ltd, Icom Security Ltd, Icom Network Cabling Ltd and Icom Facilities Management Ltd*) is a company principally engaged in the supply and installation of Telecom equipment, IT cabling and fire and security installation and maintenance.

Environmental Policy
